Thomas Fisher Resurvey of Kennett Tract, 1739

By Verdict of a Jury from the late Proprietary dated the 6th day of the 1st Month in the 1700^{Year} There was surveyed on the 10th day of Dec^r then next following unto Thomas Robinson & Thomas Fisher a Tract of Land situate in the Township of Kennet in the County of Chester, which said Tract is now situate as followeth, that is to say, Begin^g at a Corner of W^m Webb's Land & extending thence by the corner of W^m J. to a White Oak, thence by the said W^m Webb's Land & Land Lovers' Thudhor N 8 by N 242¹/₂ f^t to a post, thence by Land of Elizabeth Hardland and Ad^m Parker S 81 66¹/₂ f^t to a post, thence by Sarah Hardland's Land S 72 37 f^t to the place of Begin^g. Contain^g one hundred ninety nine Acres & a half & the Allow^g of Six Acres & Cent for Roads & High Ways. Returned unto of Sec^y Office the 15th day of January A^d 1739 - J^o B. Eastburn. J^r.
